Why do we need you?

At WWT we believe that the best way for people to understand and connect to wetlands is to experience them, so we bring awe-inspiring nature up close and let it do the talking. People feel part of something amazing and are motivated to make a difference.

By providing an excellent visitor experience you will be encouraging our visitors to make the most of their visit to Slimbridge centre, and to understand our work to save wetlands for wildlife and people. Weekends are always a popular time to people to visit and so we are looking to add to our team of volunteers to ensure that everyone has a warm welcome and we can tell them all about the exciting things that they can do during their visit.

Who will be responsible for your role?

Retail, Admissions and Membership Manager

Where will you be based?

WWT Slimbridge wetland centre

How much time will it take?

We are looking for potential volunteers who can spare anything from a couple of hours to half a day on a weekend. We need cover from 9.15 until 4.30pm and will discuss the hours you can contribute prior to offering you a placement.

If you are unable to attend on your nominated day we ask that you inform us as soon as possible so that we can arrange alternative cover.

What will you be doing?

You will be carrying out any or all of the following, according to demand on the day. For tasks that require specific skills or knowledge training will be provided and we would not expect you to carry out those tasks until you have received the training.

- Attending a morning briefing session at 9.15am on your volunteering day so that you can be provided with up-to-date information
- Providing a warm, friendly welcome to all visitors
- Interacting with visitors providing information on request. Use the Foyer map to signposting visitors around the grounds and interaction alerting visitors to specific events of interest taking place at the centre.
- Assisting with the provision of wheelchairs and electronic scooters
- Promoting membership of WWT and assisting with the signing up of new members
- Using the tills to process membership and sell items such as grain and walkabout guides
- Bagging of grain
- Answering the telephone and answering queries or redirecting them to the relevant department
- Keeping the area clean and tidy

- Delivering elements of the centre's walk and talks programme
- Spending time as a Roving Engager across the centre, making informal contact with visitors, engaging them with WWT's work and helping to enhance their visit

Who are we looking for?

To carry out this role you will need:

- Excellent verbal communication skills
- A confident attitude and / or experience in successful face-to-face contact with the public
- Commitment to excellent customer service
- An interest in and enthusiasm for the work of WWT
- The ability to work under your own initiative under the direction of the Retail, Admissions & Membership Manager
- The ability to complete forms and use an electronic till system

How will you benefit?

- This is an excellent opportunity to volunteer within an internationally important wetland site
- A great opportunity to join a friendly team, learn new skills and develop your knowledge
- Uniform is provided and discount is available in the café and shop on days you volunteer
- Free entry to all WWT wetland centres throughout the UK on presentation of your WWT name badge
- Training opportunities will be provided

General notes:

The exact hours you are able to contribute will be discussed prior to placement.

There are various options for travelling to WWT Slimbridge. Cam & Dursley rail station is a 3.5 mile cycle or taxi ride away. Unfortunately there is no bus service directly to Slimbridge: the nearest services stop is at the A38 leaving a walk through the village to reach us. Ample car parking spaces are available at the Centre, and there may be opportunities to lift share with other WWT staff or volunteers.

We regret that we are not in a position to reimburse expenses incurred in travelling to and from the centre, but any pre-agreed expenses incurred in the course of your duties will be reimbursed.

This position is entirely voluntary and is therefore unpaid. Any offer of a volunteer placement is not intended to create a legally binding contract between us and any agreement may be cancelled at any time at the discretion of either party. Neither of us intends any employment relationship to be created either now or at any time in the future.
